NOTICE TO SKIPPERS NO. 13/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 - Water Law (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233, as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 1863) State Water Holding "Polish Waters" Regional Water Management Board in Krakow hereby informs that from 14 June 2022, the shipping lane on the Vistula River from 61+200 km (Tyniec) to 79+150 km is marked in accordance with Art. 5.02 of the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure 28 April 2003 on navigation regulations on inland waterways (Dz.U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2003, No. 212, item 2027) and complies with the requirements governing the rules of night navigation. The section from 79+150 km to 80-870 km (Dabie barrage) is temporarily excluded from night navigation due to modernisation of the railway line, including the railway bridge over the Vistula River.

Night navigation is possible only for vessels whose identification, lights and signals are in accordance with the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 28 April 2003 on navigation regulations on inland waterways.
